My name is Eoin O'Reilly. I'm a Data Analyst with the Central Bank. I suppose I was attracted to the Central Bank because of public service. That was a big part of it. In the previous three and a half years that I've worked here, I've had two children. So I now take every second Friday as parental leave.

Additionally, we have in the Central Bank, we can work from home, 50% of the time. So I would come in two, two and a half days a week into the office, and then I would work the remainder of the time at home.
