Good afternoon. I trust you are well. Please see below the ISI response to Consultation Paper 136 – Enhancing our Engagement with Stakeholders

The ISI welcomes the opportunity to feed into this consultation on the review by the Central Bank of its stakeholder engagement in developing an overall strategy in this area. As is noted in the consultation document, many stakeholders, including the ISI, have several ‘touchpoints’ with the Central Bank in the course of carrying out our functions and activities. Thus, the ISI wish to echo the importance of coordination of these various engagements to ensure efficiency for both the Central Bank and its various stakeholders. To this end, perhaps consideration could be given to the development of a central coordination point or a specific contact person for a certain stakeholder for the purposes of facilitating, for example, the arrangement of high level meetings at agreed intervals to discuss progress or approaches on matters of mutual interest.

The proposals in the consultation document appear to be useful in the context of supporting the objectives of the Central Bank in building a learning organisation and providing opportunities for all stakeholders to engage. In particular, the proposed Financial System Conference is potentially a very valuable opportunity to engage efficiently with a wide variety of stakeholders on high level strategic issues in a complex system.

The ISI looks forward to continuing its engagement with the Central Bank in progressing matters of mutual interest.
