Who can use this form?

A benchmark administrator located in Ireland and authorised or registered in accordance with Article 34 of (EU) Regulation 2016/1011 (the 'Benchmark Regulation'), or any other supervised entity located in the European Union with an Irish presence and regulated by the Central Bank of Ireland ('Central Bank') with a clear and well-defined role with the control and accountability framework of a third country administrator, which is able to monitor effectively the provision of a benchmark, may apply to the Central Bank as the relevant competent authority to endorse a benchmark or a family of benchmarks provided in a third country for their use in the European Union.
