1. Children's Health Foundation

The Children's Health Foundation **supports sick children and their families**, raises funds for **life-saving medical equipment** and supports research into **treating childhood illnesses**.

2. The Down Syndrome Centre

The Down Syndrome Centre provides services to **support children with Down syndrome** so they can **reach their full potential**.

3. Cross Cancer Research

Cross Cancer Research supports **education and training** of students in their careers as **young cancer researchers**.

4. Women's Aid

Women's Aid provides direct services for **women and their dependents experiencing domestic abuse** and campaigns to stop **violence against women and children**.

5. Outhouse

Outhouse is a community and resource centre, which aims to create **a safe space for people who are LGBT+** and their families and friends.
